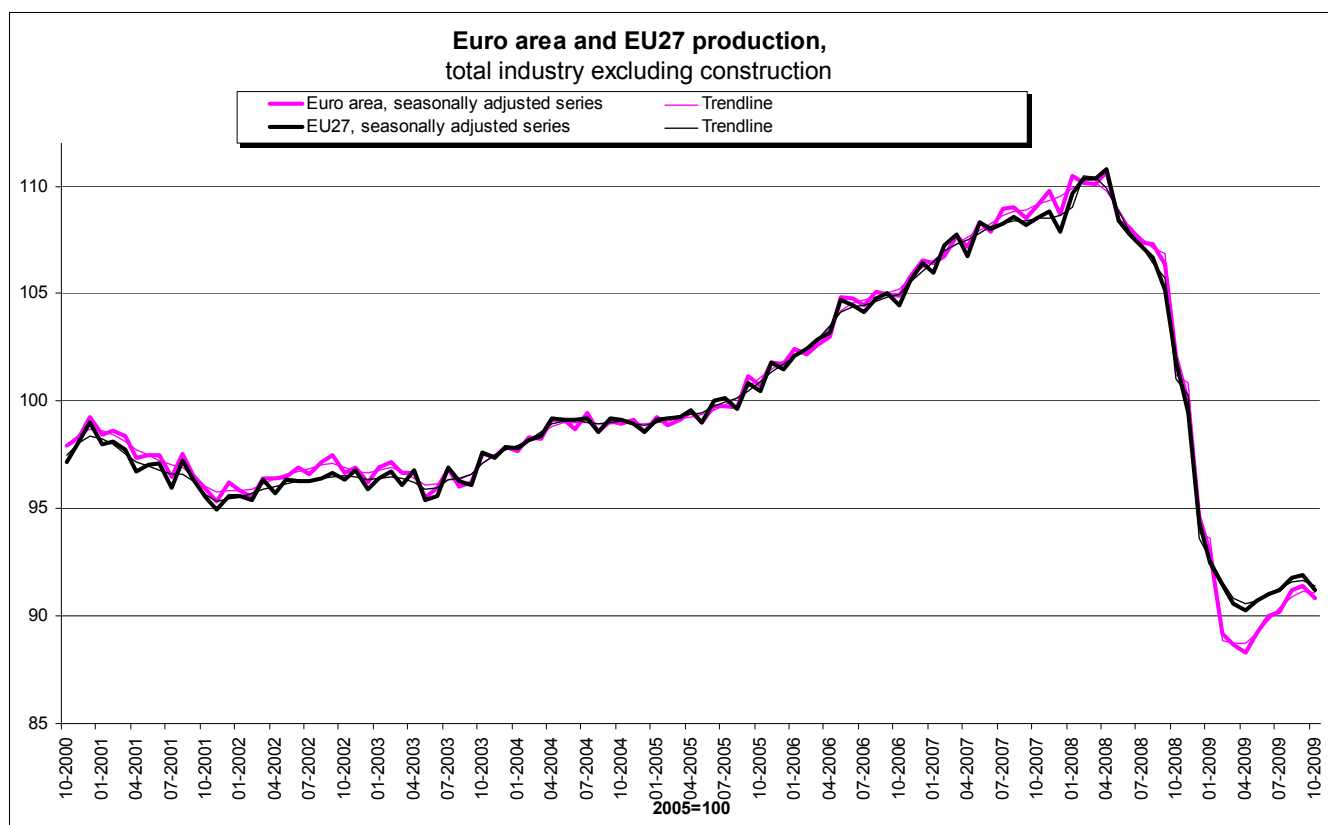
## Industrial production down by 0.6% in euro area

Down by 0.7% in EU27

In October 2009 compared with September 2009, seasonally adjusted industrial production<sup>1</sup> fell by 0.6% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA16) and by 0.7% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup>. In September<sup>3</sup> production increased by 0.2% and 0.1% respectively.

In October 2009 compared with October 2008, industrial production declined by 11.1% in the **euro area** and by 10.2% in the **EU27**.

These estimates are released by **Eurostat, the Statistical Office of the European Communities**.



## Monthly comparison

In October 2009 compared with September 2009, production of intermediate goods increased by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 0.8% in the **EU27**. Capital goods remained stable in the **euro area**, but fell by 0.1% in the **EU27**. Production of energy declined by 0.3% in both zones. Durable consumer goods dropped by 1.4% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU27**. Non-durable consumer goods decreased by 1.6% and 1.2% respectively.

Among the Member States for which data are available, industrial production rose in nine, fell in nine and remained stable in **Estonia**. The highest increases were registered in **Finland** (+2.2%), **Bulgaria** (+2.1%), the **Netherlands** and **Poland** (both +0.6%), and the largest falls in **Slovenia** (-3.2%), **Ireland** (-2.8%) and **Germany** (-1.8%).

## Annual comparison

In October 2009 compared with October 2008, production of non-durable consumer goods fell by 3.5% in the **euro area** and by 2.9% in the **EU27**. Production of energy decreased by 6.8% and 7.0% respectively. Intermediate goods declined by 12.4% in the **euro area** and by 12.0% in the **EU27**. Durable consumer goods dropped by 14.9% and 12.4% respectively. Capital goods fell by 16.3% in the **euro area** and by 15.2% in the **EU27**.

Industrial production fell in all Member States for which data are available, except **Ireland** (+2.0%) and **Poland** (+1.1%). The largest decreases were registered in **Estonia** (-20.9%), **Finland** (-19.1%) and **Slovenia** (-18.4%), and the smallest in **Romania** (-1.4%), **Portugal** (-5.2%) and the **Netherlands** (-6.1%).

1. Total industry excluding construction. According to the Council Regulation 1165/98 Eurostat publishes national seasonally adjusted data if available. For the other Member States (Bulgaria, Greece, Spain, Cyprus and Luxembourg) Eurostat performs the adjustment. This means that different methodologies are used to make the seasonal adjustment of the national series.  
The seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the working day adjusted series from individual Member States and performing an adjustment for seasonal effects on these series. Therefore the seasonally adjusted figures for total industry (excluding construction) is based directly on the working day adjusted series coming from the Member States and **not on an aggregation of the seasonally adjusted indices from the Member States**. The euro area and EU seasonally adjusted growth rates might differ from the weighted growth rates of the individual Member States (see Methodology of the industrial production index). This procedure also implies that the aggregation of the overall figures is not based on the published details (intermediate, capital, durable, non-durable goods, energy).  
Missing observations from Member States are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.
2. The euro area (EA16) includes Belgium, Germany, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 160/2009 of 12 November 2009. The figures for September 2009 were +0.3% in the euro area and +0.2% in the EU27 for the monthly changes, and -12.9% in the euro area and -12.1% in the EU27 for the yearly changes.
