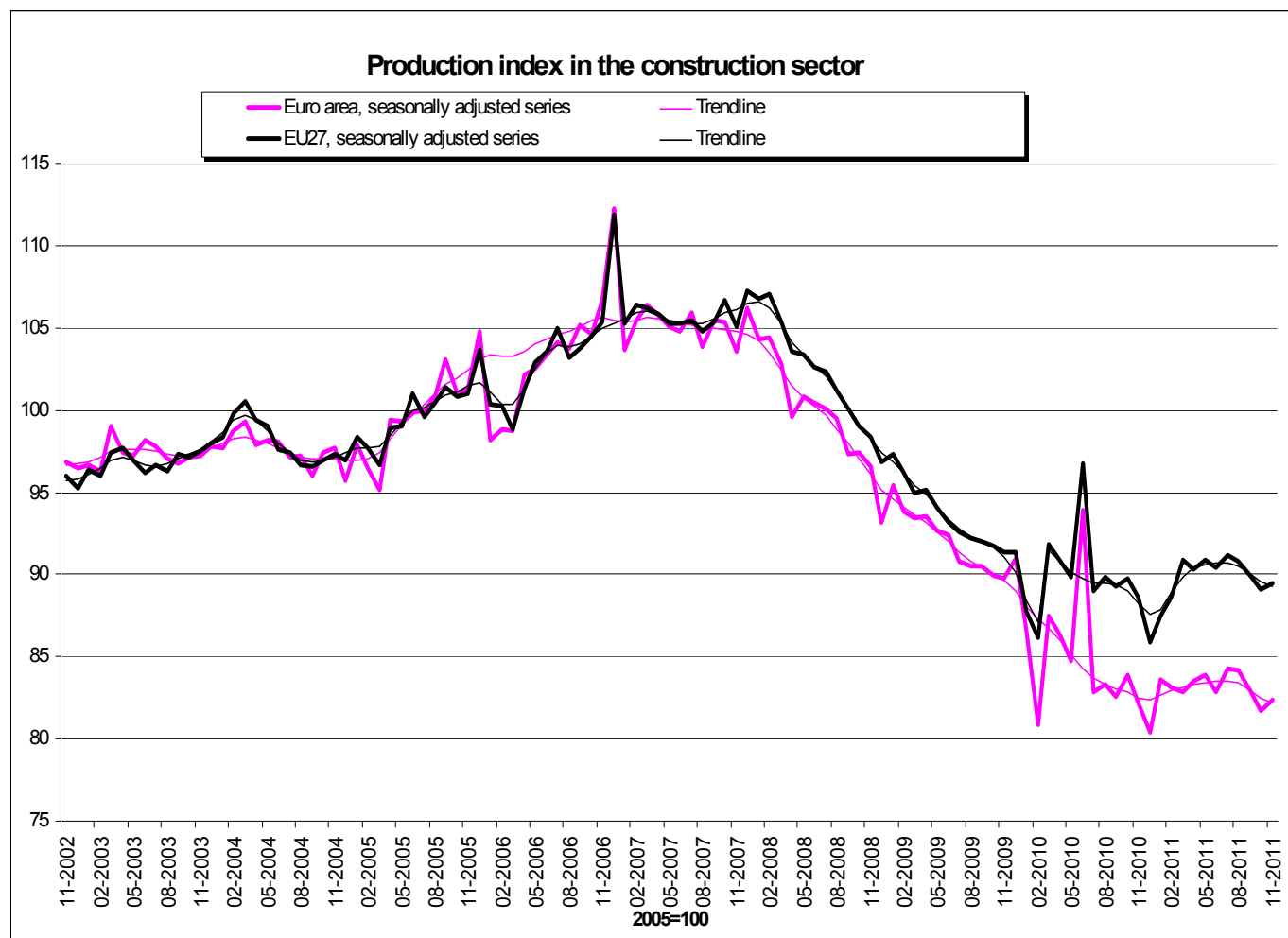
## Construction output up by 0.8% in euro area

Up by 0.4% in the EU27

In the construction sector, seasonally adjusted production<sup>1</sup> rose by 0.8% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA17) and by 0.4% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup> in November 2011, compared with the previous month. In October<sup>3</sup>, production fell by 1.4% in the **euro area** and by 0.9% in the **EU27**.

Compared with November 2010, output in November 2011 increased by 0.2% in the **euro area** and by 0.7% in the **EU27**.

These first estimates are released by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for November 2011, construction output rose in eleven and fell in **Spain** and **Slovakia** (both -0.7%) and **Bulgaria** (-0.3%). The highest increases were registered in **Slovenia** (+23.1%), **Hungary** (+7.4%) and **Germany** (+4.5%).

Building construction increased by 0.4% in the **euro area** and by 0.8% in the **EU27**, after -1.2% and -1.1% respectively in October. Civil engineering fell by 0.6% in the **euro area**, but rose by 0.1% in the **EU27**, after -1.6% and -1.2% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for November 2011, construction output rose in six and fell in eight. The highest increases were registered in **Romania** (+16.9%), **Poland** (+14.7%) and **Germany** (+9.9%), and the largest decreases in **Portugal** (-12.2%), **Bulgaria** (-10.2%) and **Slovenia** (-10.0%).

Building construction increased by 0.5% in the **euro area** and by 0.3% in the **EU27**, after -2.3% and -1.7% respectively in October. Civil engineering fell by 2.6% in the **euro area**, but rose by 1.3% in the **EU27**, after -3.3% and +0.1% respectively in the previous month.

1. The production index in construction approximates the evolution of output within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. For the Member States which produce the construction index, but do not provide data for the reference period, Eurostat estimates missing values in order to calculate euro area and EU aggregates. For total construction, and according to the Council Regulation 1165/98, Eurostat publishes national seasonally adjusted data if available. For Denmark, Estonia, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and Sweden, Eurostat makes the adjustment. The seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the working day adjusted series from individual Member States and making an adjustment for seasonal effects on these series. Therefore, the seasonally adjusted figures for total construction are based directly on the working day adjusted series from the Member States and **not on an aggregation of the seasonally adjusted indices from the Member States**. The euro area and EU seasonally adjusted growth rates might differ from the weighted growth rates of the individual Member States. Working day adjusted figures are currently transmitted by most of the Member States. For Denmark, Eurostat makes the working day adjustment. If a Member State does not supply monthly data (data not required by the regulation or data required but not yet sent), Eurostat calculates the missing series by linear interpolation from quarterly data, in order to calculate the monthly European aggregates.
2. The euro area (EA17) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in News Release 193/2011 of 19 December 2011. The monthly growth rate for October 2011 remains unchanged at -1.4% in the euro area and has been revised from -1.3% to -0.9% in the EU27. The annual growth rates have been revised from -2.8% to -2.5% in the euro area and from -2.0% to -1.4% in the EU27.
4. From this News Release onwards, Eurostat is adjusting Spanish construction data for seasonal effects.
