

New national accounts aggregates for employment Introducing EA aggregates for quarterly hours worked, annual European aggregates for detailed industry breakdown of employment in persons and hours worked

The national accounts data section has been extended with more European aggregates for the employment data. Quarterly hours worked for the euro area can now be found in the quarterly accounts branch of the online database tree, under the heading National Accounts detailed breakdowns. European annual aggregates of the A60 industry breakdown (NACE Rev 1.1) of employment in persons and the A31 industry breakdown (NACE Rev 1.1) of employment in hours worked are available under National Accounts detailed breakdowns in the annual accounts branch of the online database tree.

The quarterly aggregates will be updated with the news release of employment data around t+75 days after the end of the reference quarter. The annual aggregates will be updated at the same time as the second GDP release at around t+100 days after the end of the quarter to which the release refers (see release calendar for dates).

According to the ESA95 Transmission Programme, Member States are obliged to transmit employment figures according to the A60 industry breakdown with a delay of t+21 months after the end of the reference year. The A31 breakdown is to be transmitted at t+9 months.
